


OPPORTUNITY FOR PHARMACY LEADERSHIP AND INNOVATION:

CONTRIBUTE TO ORGANIZATIONS' FINANCIAL STABILIZATION AND GROWTH

- Identify opportunities to increase or generate revenue
- Leverage retail and specialty pharmacy services
- Support organization-level cost containment efforts



SUPPORT PHARMACY ENTERPRISE THROUGH INNOVATIONS IN CARE DELIVERY



Expand virtual visits and access to ambulatory care patients



Shift to homebased infusion services



Expand role in vaccine distribution, storage, and administration





- Implement programs that "meet the patients where they are"
- Help physicians obtain prior authorizations
- Encourage pharmacy leaders to engage in community events



BOLSTER PARTNERSHIPS

Strengthen relationships with drug suppliers and manufacturers to mitigate shortages

Collaborate with community pharmacies to expand access to medications

Collaborate with other health systems to monitor resources, capacity, and distribution systems
