A Local Application of the ASHP Student Leadership Development Workshop

OBJECTIVE

The primary goal of this event was to provide an opportunity for pharmacy students to build upon critical skills utilized in effective leadership.

PLAN

The Workshop was a collaboration between the Kansas Council of Health-Systems Pharmacists (KCHP), the Missouri Society of Health-Systems Pharmacists (MSHP), and the Greater Kansas City Society of Health-Systems Pharmacists (GKCSHP).

Leadership from each organization assisted in facilitating the event, in addition to providing funding for refreshments. The Workshop was held at the KU School of Pharmacy, and SSHP members from the nearby UMKC School of Pharmacy were invited to attend. Maximum capacity for the workshop was set at 50 students; 25 each from both KU and UMKC.

OUTCOME

The Workshop was attended by 45 students and supported by 6 facilitators. Students and local pharmacy leaders networked over refreshments prior to the event. The Workshop opened with a lecture, and concluded with group presentations and peer review.
